Dear Parents of Boys Resident Campers,

At Resident Camp, we offer many outstanding programs for your child. Some of our programs that we plan and implement for your son require additional permission. Signature form was done on line with your registration and signed electronically. Please fill out all enclosed forms. We have listed the extra forms, because these four forms are only specific to Resident Camp.

**PLEASE RETURN ALL FORMS ON OR BEFORE JUNE 1, 2017**

The extra forms are as follows and are also enclosed with this letter:

- 1. Summer Food Application** (ALL CAMPERS)  
The Summer Food Application is required for **ALL** campers. Each year, we participate in the Summer Food Program which ensures that all of our campers receive a daily, balanced diet while away at Resident Camp. By completing the form, we are able to determine if you son qualifies for this program.
- 2. Confidential Form** (ALL CAMPERS)  
This forms provides additional information from parents about your child, so staff at Heinz House Camp can better serve him while he is away from home.
- 3. Ropes Course Permission Slip** (ALL CAMPERS)  
The Ropes Course Permission Slip **must be completed for each camper** that is attending Resident Camp. At Resident Camp, the campers can participate in our Low and High Ropes Course. Campers are able to build leadership and teamwork skills as they complete our Low Ropes Course, which challenges the camper to complete an element that sits only one foot of the ground. The High Ropes Course challenges our campers to face their fears and build confidence as they complete elements that are forty feet off the ground, with the use of a harness. As the parent/guardian, you must complete the form and specify if you give or not give permission for your son to participate in the program.
- 4. Paintball Permission** (AGE 12 AND OLDER)  
On our 110-acre campus, our older campers have the opportunity to participate in our Paintball Program. Before any camper goes to the course, they are instructed on how to safely use the equipment so they do not hurt themselves or their peers. This program is strictly optional and is only offered to our campers that are 12 years and older.

Also included in this mailing is the **Boys Resident Camp Handbook**. The Handbook outlines all of our policies, procedures, and important dates to remember in regards to Boys Resident Camp only.
