Thank you for your patience these past months as we have monitored the ongoing global pandemic, COVID-19. Despite our eagerness to welcome kids back to Sarah Heinz House, we have always maintained that we would only do so when we could do so safely. Although we wish the day had come sooner, we are delighted to announce that we will be offering limited spots for onsite summer programs, as well as virtual "Leave No Trace" programs with Mr. Dan Turkovich, our Resident Camp Director!

Due to the current state of Yellow, we have had to restructure our summer programs. To ensure necessary social distancing and other safety procedures can be followed, we have reduced the number of campers we can serve this summer, as well as the way in which we serve them. Although a number of things will be different, our commitment to providing a well-rounded experience that includes recreation, art, learning and socialization (albeit in small groups) remains.

Starting on June 15, we will host programming for pre-school and school aged youth (age 3 to those who have completed 6th grade). Our team has spent countless hours developing safe spaces for open play, STEAM activities to spark young minds and creativity, and mobility and pool plans to ensure sanitation throughout the day. I am proud to be part of this team who has thoughtfully planned for your child(ren).

For those who have already registered, your spot remains and we are excited to serve your children.
